

Planting Guide:

Crop Uses: Cut, solitary, group planting, rock garden,

cottage garden, tubs, cosmetics, bee pasture,

scented garden, rose garden

Description: The true lavender (Lavandula angustifolia) is a bushy, clump-forming evergreen perennial that forms purple, throat-shaped, panicle-shaped flowers with a strong scent. In a sunny spot with well drained, nutrient-rich soil, it usually reaches a height of about 30 cm and becomes about 30 cm wide.

Plant Location: Preferred in a sunny location.

Medium/ Soil Type: Commercially available potted plant soil or normal ground.
