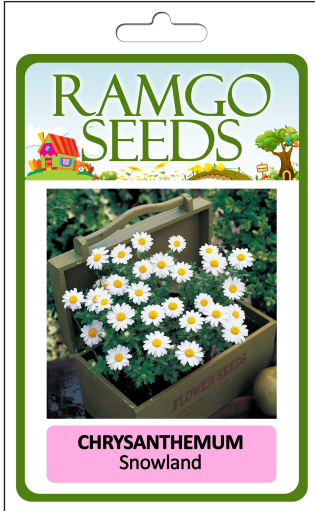


Chrysanthemum



Snowland is a paludosum type Chrysanthemum. It thrives in warm temperatures and long days, covering itself in clear white daisy-like flowers with yellow disks. Uniform, with flowers that are larger than most paludosum types. Outstanding garden performance.

Planting Guide:

Life Cycle: Annual

Characteristics: compact plants provide a tremendous show of flowers throughout the growing season. Flowers are 1.5 inches across, larger than other paludosum Chrysanthemums

Market Use: Excellent bedding plant, spring sales, great in mixed containers

Plant Height: 8 – 10 inches

Planting Method: Transplanting

Seedling tray: Use 288 holes or 512 holes

Container/ Pot Size: 4 - 6" Width

Light Requirement: Sun/Partial Shade

Days of Germination: 10 - 14 days

Sowing to Transplanting: 4 - 6 weeks

Days to Flower from Sowing: 65 - 75 days
