"Rosemary"

Rosemary a fragrant plants great for herb gardens, adding scent to mixed combinations, or bring a pot inside to use fresh in your kitchen. Rosemary is a fast-growing, upright hedge of aromatic, needle-like foliage. Holds its flavour and aroma in cooking. Best in containers or in-ground.

Planting Guide:

- Scientific Name :** Rosmarinus officinalis
- Maturity Days:** 42 days after transplanting
- Temperature Requirement:** Plant in Full Sun (at least 6 hrs of direct sunlight)
- Planting Distance:** 12 - 18" (30 - 46cm) apart
- Plant Height:** 12 - 24" (30 - 61cm) tall
- Plant Width:** 12 - 24" (30 - 61cm) wide
- Temperature:** 65 - 85F
- Germination Time:** 14 - 28 days
- Container Size:** Single plant in a 3.5" pot.
- Soil pH Level:** Between 6.0 and 7.0
- Soil Type:** Grow best in well-drained, loamy, slightly acidic soil.
- Fertilization:** Some rosemary needs fertilizer. If growth is too slow or the plant appears stunted or pale yellow, apply fertilizer once before the new growth appears. Any all purpose fertilizer in dry or liquid form is suitable as long as it is applied correctly. To prevent leaf burning, avoid applying fertilizer directly onto the plant.
