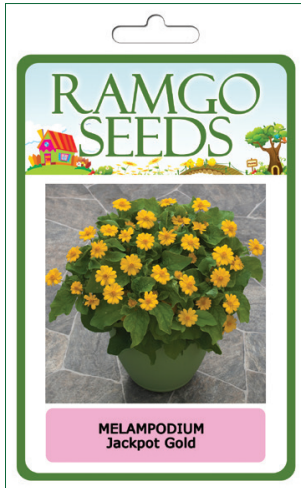




MELAMPODIUM
"Jackpot Gold"

Planting Guide:

A fantastic bedding plant choice! 'Jackpot Gold' stays compact and has large, cheerful, golden flowers. Sure to be loved for the ever-present 2" blooms, plants thrive in hot and humid conditions. Use like zinnias and marigolds for borders and beds; or in containers, mixed or on its own.

Latin Name: Melampodium paludosum

Color: Yellow

Exposition: Full Sun

Usage: Container and Flower Bed

Plant Height: 15 - 30 cm

Maturity days: 50-60 days

Plant Description:

- Ideal as bedding and landscape
- Thrives under full sun
- Self-clean with new flowers covering the old flowers so plant continues to have fresh flowers all season

CULTURAL RECOMMENDATIONS:

Sowing: Use 392-288 plug or seedling tray

Plant Container Size: 4-inches pot

Germination: Emergence 7-10 days

Seedling Finish Time: 3-5 weeks in a 288 tray

Bloom Period: 15 - 25 days after transplanting

NOTES:

- Seeds have a tendency to push themselves out of the media if not covered
- Avoid saturated media in plug trays

Fertilizer Management

STAGES	DAYS AFTER SOWING	FERTILIZER/ PESTICIDE	AMOUNT	APPLICATION
Seedling	5 Days	Atonik Forte	1 sachet/16 liter of water	Side dressing
Vegetative	12 Days	Complete	½ tsp/ plant	Side dressing
	19 Days	Manusol (30-10-10)	½ tsp/ hand sprayer	Spraying
	25 Days	Complete	½ tsp/ plant	Side dressing
	35 Days	Complete	½ tsp/ plant	Side dressing
Flowering	From 39 (DAT) until its growing period	15-15-30 Fertilizer	½ tsp/ plant	Side dressing

Notes: Seeds have a tendency to push themselves out of the media if not covered
Avoid saturated media in seedling trays

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
