

Planting Guide:

Family: Apiaceae

Scientific Name: Petroselinum crispum

Adaptability: 7 – 16°C (mean monthly temperature)

Maturity: 60 – 70 days (AFTER SOWING)

Planting Distance: 10 – 20 cm X 45 – 60 cm

Plant Population (per ha): 83,333 – 222,222 hills

Seeding Rate (g/ha):

42 – 111 (at 2,000 seeds per gram and distance of 30–40 cm X 30–40 cm)

28 – 74 (at 3,000 seeds per gram and distance of 30–40 cm X 30–40 cm)

Number of Seeds (per gram): 2,000-3,000

Method of Planting: best transplanted

Days From Sowing To Germination: 10 – 14

Days From Germination To Transplanting: 14

pH Requirement: 5-7

Fertilizer Management:

Basal: (2 days before transplanting)	chicken manure (1 kg/m²)	+	14-14-14 (20 g/m²)	+	46-0-0 (10 g/m²)
1st Sidedressing (10-15 days after transplanting)	21-0-0 (3-4 bags/ha)				
2nd Sidedressing (25-30 days after transplanting)	21-0-0 (3-4 bags/ha)				
3rd Sidedressing (40-45 days after transplanting)	21-0-0 (3-4 bags/ha)				

Note: Sidedressing could be applied along the rows of plants in solution (100 – 150 gms / 5 gal of water).

Harvesting: clipping / ratooning

--- stems of outer leaves are cut off as they reach a length of 12 –17 cm
